


# Sundance: Films, parties, networking keep festival-goers busy

But many of the more talked-about films out here I am yet to see.

Films such as "Blue Caprice," "Concussion," "Before Midnight," "C.O.G.," "Toy's House," "We Are What We Are" and "Running From Crazy," for instance. I truly look forward to seeing all of these and more.

Parties and meetings are among the activities in Sundance that are unique to this event.



Then there are those who watch seven films a day, one right after the other. Those are the buyers, programmers and critics. They basically live in the movie theaters.

I fall somewhere in between. Watching a marathon of movies is sort of heaven for me and I plan on doing that on my last day here.

As a juror this year at Slamdance, I also still must finish viewing the 12 films in competition in the Dramatic Feature category, so that has to be integrated into my schedule as well. That and convening with my co-jurors to determine who the grand prize will go to. That is an exciting responsibility I feel honored to be a part of.

Until later, see you at the movies.


